The frog explains that this is water from a real moor and how important moors are for the environment.

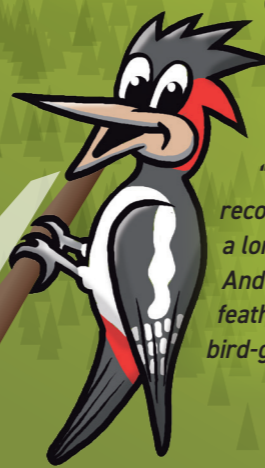
"I feel especially comfortable here," he says contentedly. Hopsi looks around and also spots many small insects happily flying between the water and the plants.

Snow cannons help him with this: all he needs is water and cold temperatures, and little crystals appear – the technical snow.

Then Hopsi hops into his slope machine and prepares the pistes so the guests can start skiing first thing in the morning. Afterward, he snuggles up in his comfy burrow and looks forward to the new day.

Kasalm

Real Cheese!

On the alpine meadows, the cows give especially good milk. *"That's because we eat lots of fresh herbs here,"* says a cow, grazing contentedly. This milk is used to make Ennstal Styrian cheese.

Mausi's Styrian cheese recipe:

Add salt and pepper to 1 kg of low-fat quark and mix well. Squeeze out the fluid through a sieve. Weigh down the quark a little in the sieve and leave for 1-2 days. Place the quark onto a cloth and leave in a warm place for a few days (until cracks develop). Then lay a damp cloth over it and put it in a cool place. Turn daily for 4-6 weeks until it turns a grey-brown colour.

Real skillful!

Hopsi jumps over mountain pastures and observes a herd of cows grazing on the lush meadows. When he sits on a bench, a shepherd comes.

"It's great to see you hop so lightly across the pasture!" Hopsi explains that he has improved his agility through lots of training. He looks toward the 2,995-metre Dachstein and says, *"I will keep training and stand up there someday."*

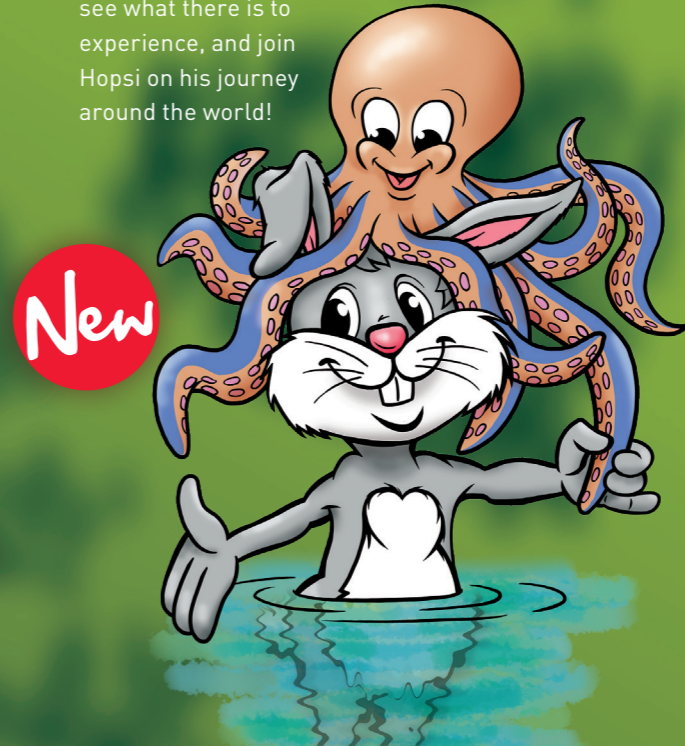
Hopsis great adventure continues!
