Inspect the trail and its features. Take it easy at first and get ready for your day on the mountain.

**RE-RIDE**

Ride the trail multiple times and learn its features and characteristics. Feel the flow.

**FREE-RIDE**

Progress step by step. Gradually increase your speed and approach larger features according to your skill level.

## 303 Rohrmoos Tour

↔ 43.0km ↑↓ 775m

As a connection between Bikepark Schladming and the Reiteralm Trails, the Rohrmoos Tour runs through the landscapes of Schladming, Rohrmoos and Pichl without major climbs. Along the way, there are many opportunities to stop for refreshments. Ideal for beginners with little mountain biking experience. Riding permitted: 1 hour after sunrise until 1 hour before sunset.

## 304 Planai Tour

↔ 35.6km ↑↓ 1,271m

A relaxed ride through the Talbach Gorge into Untertal and via partly asphalted mountain roads to the Planai mid-station. From here, the highlight of the tour begins with the Uphill Flow Trail. The easy route leads with a moderate incline through mountain forests and a high moor. The descent is either via the blue trails in the bike park or entirely via the Planai road back to Schladming.

## R7 Enns Cycle Path

The Enns cycle path is the ideal connection from Pichl to the Singletrack Haus-Aich. The flat cycle route runs alongside the Enns river, car-free, heading east or west.
