Water shapes the landscape of Schladming–Dachstein in a truly distinctive way. Mountain lakes, springs and waterfalls accompany hikes through the alpine scenery, providing refreshing moments time and again – whether pausing along the trail or consciously taking a deep breath in a quiet spot by the water.

Along selected themed trails such as the “Wilde Wasser Trail” in Rohrmoos or on multi-day routes like the Schladminger Tauern High Trail, new perspectives on the region's diverse world of water continually unfold. Emerald-green mountain lakes, rushing streams and impressive waterfalls make every tour varied and vibrant.

Mountain lakes, in particular, leave a lasting impression on the landscape of Schladming–Dachstein. The Giglach Lakes, Lake Spiegelsee and the Styrian Lake Bodensee are outstanding examples of the region's diverse alpine waters. They invite visitors to pause, let their gaze wander across the mountains or simply take a break by the shore. Whether as a peaceful moment along the way or the destination of a day trip, water accompanies summer in Schladming–Dachstein in a most natural way.

Nestled between the impressive valleys of the Niedere Tauern and the striking peaks of the Dachstein massif lies one of the most diverse hiking regions in the Alps. Emerald-green mountain lakes, rushing waterfalls and sweeping panoramic views shape the landscape and turn every tour into a memorable nature experience.

A well-developed network of more than 1,500 kilometres of marked hiking trails offers routes for all levels – from leisurely alpine pasture paths and family-friendly themed walks to challenging mountain tours. Eight summer mountain cable cars make the ascent easier, allowing you to comfortably gain elevation and fully enjoy the breathtaking scenery. With over 300 mountain lakes, numerous springs and impressive gorges, Schladming-Dachstein is also one of the most water-rich regions in Styria.

For those who wish to experience the landscape over several days, long-distance hiking trails such as the Dachstein Circular Trail or the Schladminger Tauern High Trail provide ideal conditions. Suitable packages can be booked directly through the Schladming-Dachstein Tourist Board. Along the way, traditional alpine huts invite you to take enjoyable breaks, combining nature experiences with regional cuisine.

The high quality of the hiking infrastructure is reflected in official recognitions: Ramsau am Dachstein and Schladming are certified Austrian Hiking Villages, known for excellently signposted trails, expert advice and particularly hiker-friendly services. With the Schladming-Dachstein Card, guests also benefit from free hiking buses and the use of the mountain cable cars.

The region offers ideal conditions for a successful family holiday in the heart of the Styrian mountains. Across the seven summer mountains, a wide range of attractions awaits young and old explorers alike – from Hopsiland on the Planai and the summer toboggan run on the Rittisberg to adventure playgrounds on the Hauser Kaibling, as well as several adventure and climbing parks.

Themed and adventure trails such as the “Schafsinn” circular trail on the Hauser Kaibling or the Fairy Tale Trail on the Rittisberg combine exercise with play, storytelling and nature. The offer is complemented by numerous stroller-friendly hiking paths, water and nature experiences, playgrounds and family-oriented climbing opportunities.

With the Schladming-Dachstein Card, many leisure activities for families can be enjoyed free of charge or at a reduced rate – from mountain cable cars to popular attractions. This makes Schladming-Dachstein a diverse destination for families who value nature, variety and quality time together.

A special highlight for active families is the Singletrack Haus-Aich: a family-friendly mountain bike trail park with around five kilometres of purpose-built trails. The varied course is ideal for beginners, children and families. Along the route, the “Bikeland Heroes” puzzle rally adds extra fun with playful challenges and shared achievements – an experience that uniquely combines activity, adventure and nature.

The region offers ideal conditions for all cyclists – whether you prefer leisurely rides or thrilling downhill runs, you'll find a wide variety of routes for every skill level. In total, 26 designated bike tours are available, complemented by 14 bike & hike routes that combine cycling with rewarding alpine summit experiences.

Ambitious riders can look forward to sporting challenges and plenty of riding fun at the Bikepark Schladming and on the trails of the Reiteralp. Demanding lines, varied descents and perfectly maintained tracks ensure unforgettable biking experiences in an alpine setting.

A particular highlight is the Singletrack Haus-Aich, which is ideal for family outings. Thanks to additional route options and optimized lines, it offers diverse opportunities for both beginners and experienced riders – ranging from playful sections to more technically challenging passages.

Those who prefer to explore the region at a more relaxed pace will find ideal conditions on scenic cycling routes such as the Enns Cycle Path, perfect for enjoying the landscape, villages and nature at leisure. The offer is complemented by specialized bike hotels providing secure bike storage, washing facilities, repair services and additional amenities – ensuring the best conditions for a thoroughly enjoyable cycling holiday.

Sustainable production and regional value creation make indulgence not only delicious, but also traceable and authentic.

A special culinary highlight is “Almkulinarik by Richard Rauch”. In collaboration with the award-winning Styrian chef, 16 selected alpine huts reinterpret traditional mountain dishes. Classic recipes are refined with a contemporary touch, regional ingredients are creatively combined and prepared with great attention to detail – down-to-earth, authentic and modern at the same time.

Whether during a sunny break at an alpine hut, on a scenic gourmet hike or as part of special culinary events, summer in Schladming-Dachstein is also a true culinary experience. Indulgence surrounded by nature, accompanied by impressive mountain panoramas and warm hospitality, creates moments that will be remembered for a long time.

Schladming-Dachstein offers ideal conditions for anyone drawn to the rock – from the very first hold to demanding alpine routes. More than 30 via ferratas of varying difficulty levels, seven via ferrata practice areas and over 1,000 alpine climbing routes provide a wide range of options for beginners and experienced climbers alike.

A particular highlight is the Dachstein South Face via ferrata, one of the most spectacular and challenging via ferratas in the Alps. Its immense rock walls and true alpine scale make it an unforgettable experience for skilled mountaineers.

The region also offers excellent opportunities for families and newcomers to climbing. Numerous family-friendly climbing facilities provide a safe and playful introduction to the sport. The Rittisberg, in particular, has established itself as a versatile adventure mountain for climbers of all ages: its via ferrata and nearby climbing garden offer ideal conditions to develop technique, confidence and safety in manageable terrain.

Another popular meeting point for young climbing enthusiasts is the Eldorado via ferrata in Ramsau am Dachstein, as well as the via ferrata practice area at Stoderzinken, which is specifically designed to meet the needs of children and teenagers and allows for a gentle introduction to the world of climbing.

With well-secured routes, modern infrastructure and the support of certified mountain and climbing guides, Schladming-Dachstein provides the perfect setting for every individual climbing experience.

The Golf & Country Club Schloss Pichlarn, located near Aigen im Ennstal, offers wide views of the Grimming mountain. The offer is complemented by the Radstadt Golf Club and the Ennstal-Weißenbach Golf & Country Club, each featuring distinctive course layouts and harmonious integration into the natural surroundings.

In the Schladming-Dachstein region, you can look forward not only to top-class skiing, but to a winter holiday set against an impressive mountain panorama. Between the Schladminger Tauern and the Dachstein massif, everyone finds their own personal moment of happiness – whether enjoying a relaxed day on the slopes or seeking sporting challenges.



Fun on the slopes? Small ski areas full of winter joy.

In addition to the 4-Mountain Ski Area Schladming, Schladming-Dachstein is also home to several smaller ski resorts that are particularly popular with families, beginners and those seeking a more relaxed pace. The Rittisberg in Ramsau am Dachstein delights visitors with its family-friendly atmosphere, practice lifts and fairy-tale forest – ideal for children. The Galsterberg offers gentle slopes, traditional alpine huts and one of the longest floodlit toboggan runs in the region.

At the Planneralm and Riesneralm, the two highest ski resorts in Styria, you can experience genuine natural snow conditions surrounded by unspoilt mountain scenery. And on the Fageralm, the motto is “slow down and enjoy.” The sunny high plateau impresses with magnificent panoramic views, charming alpine huts and dedicated children’s facilities that make every winter day special.



Feeling adventurous? Enjoy a wide range of experiences beyond the slopes.

Seven toboggan runs provide action and fun beyond the skiing slopes. Non-skiers can comfortably use the gondolas and enjoy the mountain panorama and crisp alpine air along clearly marked winter hiking trails. Ski touring enthusiasts will also find numerous designated routes throughout the region – ranging from leisurely to challenging. Specially marked piste ski tours are ideal for beginners, allowing you to ascend at your own pace and then enjoy the descent on perfectly groomed slopes.

Schladming-Dachstein is part of Austria's greatest skiing experience, Ski amadé – and with the 4-Mountain Ski Area Schladming, an unforgettable skiing adventure awaits, guaranteed to set every skier's heart racing. The four interconnected mountains – Hauser Kaibling, Planai, Hochwurzen and Reiteralms – offer 123 kilometres of continuous pistes, delivering variety, sporting challenges and true alpine highlights. Look forward to modern lift facilities, enhanced comfort, breathtaking views and unlimited fun on the slopes.

Each of the four mountains has its own character – together, they offer everything that makes a perfect day of skiing:

At **Hauser Kaibling**, you can enjoy wide carving slopes, cosy mountain huts, Wollis Kids Park for beginners in the valley and the highest point of the ski area at 2,015 metres, with sweeping views over the Enns Valley.

Planai brings World Cup atmosphere to the slopes – featuring the famous Planai finish slope, the legendary Night Race and the Superpark, the freestyle hotspot of the region.

Hochwurzen impresses with its fun slope, speed track and – for those who simply can't get enough – opportunities for night skiing and night tobogganing.

And **Reiteralms**? This mountain stands for sporty and action-packed challenges – from the Crosspark and Skimovie course to Speedy, Cool Running and the Black Quartet – and is also known as a training ground for the ski elite.

New this winter: Two state-of-the-art lifts provide a comfortable upgrade to the Schladming 4-Mountain Ski Area. At Hauser Kaibling, a new 10-seater gondola will enhance capacity and comfort, while on the Planai a modern 8-seater chairlift ensures even faster connections. The Fageralm also welcomes a new addition: a new 8-seater gondola now offers a particularly comfortable ascent to the sunny high plateau.

 ***Ready to indulge? Discover the taste of winter in Schladming–Dachstein.***

After a few sweeping downhill runs, when your legs begin to tire and your appetite sets in, it's time for a well-deserved culinary break. Whether it's a hearty beef soup, traditional cheese dumplings or a sweet treat, the cosy mountain huts of the region serve dishes prepared with care and genuine Styrian hospitality.

The menu features classics such as roast pork, Styrian cheese "nocken" made with the region's distinctive Ennstal mountain cheese, or freshly baked apple strudel and Kaiserschmarren. Those looking for something a little more extraordinary will find it with Almkulinarik by Richard Rauch, where award-winning gourmet cuisine meets traditional alpine dishes – creative, regional and refreshingly different. What begins as a simple stop for refreshments quickly becomes a culinary highlight of your ski day.

 ***Spectacular views? Experience your high-altitude adventure on the Dachstein.***

Where the air is clearer, the views stretch farther and every moment becomes unforgettable – that's the Dachstein. The journey itself is already an experience: the panoramic cable car takes you straight into the high-alpine winter world at 2,700 metres above sea level.

At the top, breathtaking views await – along with exceptional cuisine at the new, modern Dachstein Glacier Restaurant. Regional specialties are served alongside a spectacular 280-degree panoramic view, creating a true feast for the senses. There are also plenty of opportunities to stay active: enjoy cross-country skiing on up to 15 kilometres of groomed trails or set out on a winter hike through the glacier landscape, for example along the prepared path to the Seethaler Hut.

Spectacular and unforgettable highlights include the suspension bridge, the dizzying Stairway to Nothingness, the mysterious Ice Palace and the impressive Sky Walk. Together, they turn your visit to the Dachstein into an adventure between sky and ice – complete with guaranteed goosebump moments. In its quiet, majestic beauty, the Dachstein offers views that will stay with you long after your visit.

 ***Family fun? An experience for young and old alike.***

Whether it's first turns in the snow or shared ski days with panoramic views – in Schladming-Dachstein, skiers of all ages are well catered for. Family skiing is a true priority here, with gentle practice slopes, dedicated children's areas and cosy mountain huts for a well-deserved break in between.

The 4-Mountain Ski Area Schladming offers plenty for families and children: wide, clearly laid-out pistes, modern lifts with child safety features and well-equipped family areas with playful figures, magic carpets, children's ski routes and dedicated lifts ensure that young skiers feel especially comfortable. On the Planai, the Hopsi Children's Area delights young guests, while Wollis Kids Park features a 24,000 m² beginner's area right at the valley station of Hauser Kaibling. Hochwurzen impresses with fun slopes, and the Reiteralp offers a sunny children's ski area.

The smaller ski resorts are also particularly popular with families. At the Rittisberg in Ramsau, gentle slopes, magic carpets and a fairy-tale forest with talking figures await. The Galsterberg features the "Gallic Ski Village," a lovingly designed children's area with talking Romans, Gallic heroes and plenty of space to explore, as well as easy-to-navigate pistes and a toboggan run. On the Fageralm, several creatively designed children's ski routes, a wave track, boardercross and the Speedy course turn a ski day into an adventure for kids.

Starting from winter 2025/26, family ski holidays will become even more relaxed: all children up to the age of six (born in 2020 or later) ski free of charge. This offer is valid on all mountains of the 4-Mountain Ski Area Schladming, as well as in the Rittisberg, Galsterberg and Fageralm ski areas. The Dachstein Glacier cable car is also included.

And if you feel like taking a day off from skiing, winter hiking trails, exciting toboggan runs and, of course, a cup of hot chocolate in a cosy hut are waiting. That's what a winter holiday for all generations looks like.



Snow-active? Tobogganing fun, horse-drawn sleigh rides and new winter perspectives.

Schladming-Dachstein also impresses beyond the ski slopes. Toboggan runs such as the one on the Hochwurzen (7 km, floodlit) promise fast-paced descents, as do the runs on the Rittisberg, Planneralm and Galsterberg. For a more romantic experience, enjoy a horse-drawn sleigh ride through Ramsau, where the snow-covered winter landscape feels like something out of a fairy tale.

Those who don't want to miss out on cycling in winter can hop on a fat bike – its wide tires are perfectly suited for snowy trails. Ice skaters can glide across the ice at Lake Putterersee or at the new ice rink in Schladming. Whether traditional or trendy, winter in Schladming-Dachstein offers something for everyone.

Winter also reveals its quiet beauty on foot. Around 300 kilometres of winter hiking and snowshoe trails lead through forests, valleys and across the mountains of the region. And for those seeking a mindful start to the day, ski yoga sessions right by the slopes offer the perfect combination of clear views, fresh mountain air and calm breathing.

Ramsau am Dachstein is one of Europe's most renowned cross-country skiing centres. Across 220 kilometres of trails – many offering impressive views of the majestic Dachstein – leisure skiers and professionals alike can experience the full diversity of Nordic skiing.

High above, directly on the Dachstein Glacier at 2,700 metres, the world's longest glacier cross-country trail awaits – a truly unique high-alpine experience.

When the day winds down, Schladming-Dachstein transforms into a stage for special winter experiences – beneath a sparkling starry sky.

Night tobogganing on the Hochwurzen and the Galsterberg offers fast-paced descents on floodlit runs – an experience guaranteed to get your heart racing and make you feel the crisp winter air even more intensely. Those who prefer skis can enjoy night skiing on the Hochwurzen, gliding down perfectly groomed and illuminated slopes.

Ski tourers also find ideal conditions in the evening. Designated routes lead uphill at your own pace, accompanied by silence, the crunch of snow underfoot and views of the glittering lights in the valley below.

For cross-country enthusiasts who don't want to miss out on the evening atmosphere, the floodlit trail in Ramsau provides perfect conditions. Around 2.8 kilometres are illuminated for both classic and skating styles. And when the full moon bathes the landscape in silver light, the floodlights are turned off – revealing the trail at its most peaceful and beautiful. An unforgettable experience for those who appreciate quiet winter moments.

In this way, winter evenings in Schladming-Dachstein become a showcase for adventure, activity and truly magical moments.
